## Justice for all

People often measure a law firm's success by their trial verdicts and settlement results. While those figures are very important to a deserving client or grieving family, the action taken after the settlement can also be rewarding. For example...

- We received a **\$6.5 million verdict** in Columbus against the state of Ohio for a young man who suffered a severe brain injury when his motorcycle struck an unmarked cone placed on Interstate 71 during night road-cleaning. After this case, the state used reflective cones during all night road projects.
- We settled a claim for **\$5.75 million** against an

international pharmaceutical company for a man who received a liver transplant as a result of taking a defective pain medication. The drug was ultimately taken off the market.

- We obtained an award of **\$850,000** for the family of a man killed when his clothing got caught in an unguarded conveyor belt. His employer was forced to implement a safety program and install guards on all machines in their plant.
- A 65-year-old woman received a **\$475,000 settlement** for injuries she received when the driver of a delivery van crossed the center line, striking her car head-on. The delivery company changed the way they screened potential drivers as a result of this case.
